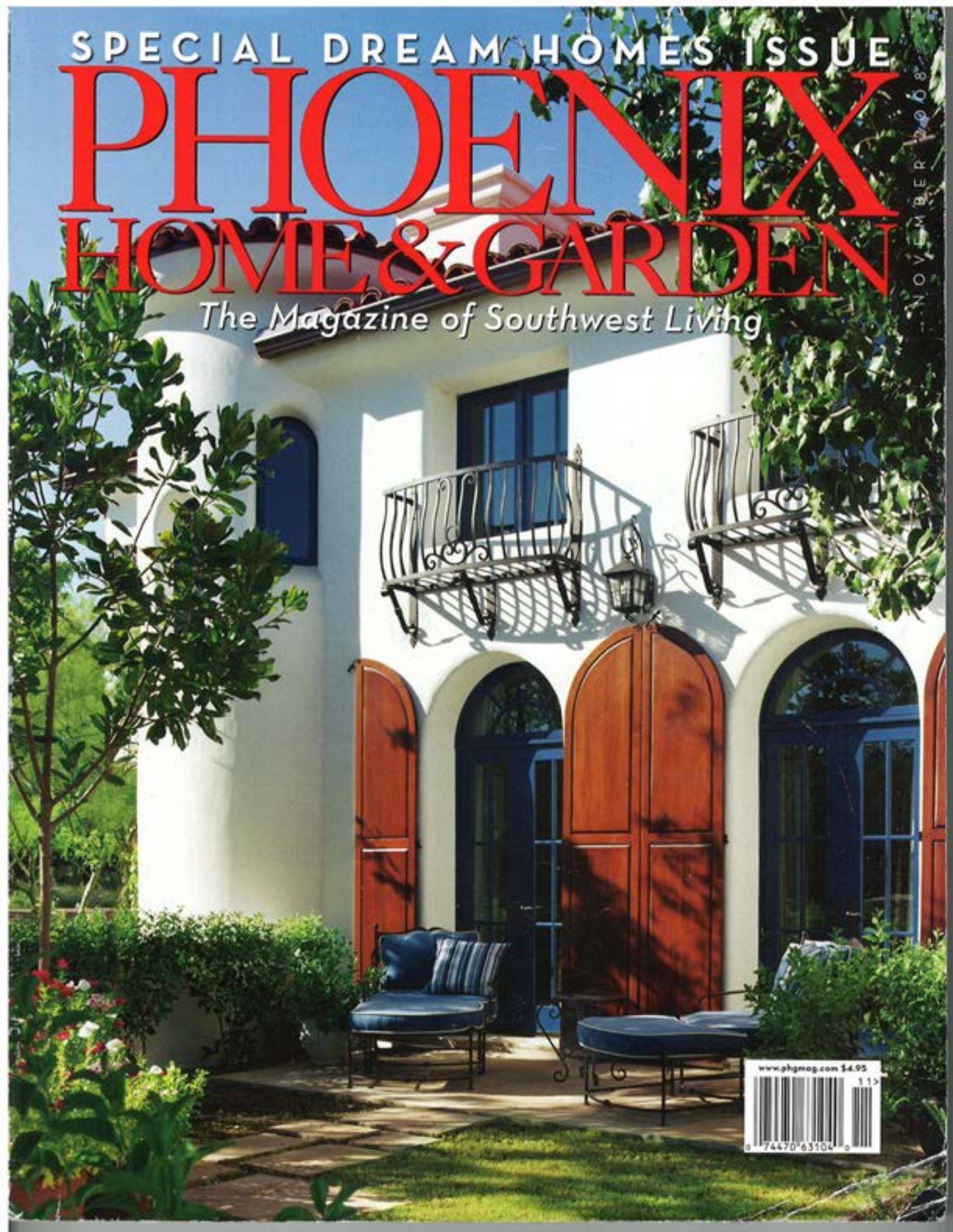

This page: Suspended glass shelving lit with fiber optics sets off a Lalique crystal collection along this hallway that leads to a breakfast area.

Opposite: Looking out to Echo Canyon, the great room celebrates the home's color, comfort and curves. Custom suede sofas wear persimmon, while a circular black granite cocktail table quietly houses audio-visual components. A plasma television hangs on a fireplace wall clad in multi-veined marble.

This page: Colorful glassware rests on shelves in the great room wet bar, which is crafted of exotic fiddleback anigre and bubinga woods. The stools also are bubinga. Cone-shaped stainless steel pendants offer ambient light.

This page: In the master bath, an Egyptian marble bench extends outside the large glass-walled shower, which is finished with glass subway tiles. The vanity top also is formed of Egyptian marble; the vanity wall is granite. **Opposite:** A white marble fireplace surround in the master bedroom is set against white suede panels intersected by stainless steel bands.





Clockwise from top left: The home's lower level is full of color, including blues, purples and greens. In the main sitting area, two blue and purple suede sofas sit on a custom rug with a matching color palette. ■ In the lower level's entertainment area, a transparent wine cellar is fitted with rack bottle storage. ■ The upper-level powder room is finished in rich persimmon wallpaper. A single mini-crystal chandelier looks like many in the reflection of the mirrored wall. An Absolute Black granite vanity holds an underlit onyx vessel sink. **Opposite:** Opening to the breakfast and great rooms, the kitchen features cabinetry of bubinga and anigre by European Design that coordinates with the home's two bar areas. Some appliances also are clad in the woods. The range and hood are stainless steel.
